ANOTHER NEW LOW: Screens at a foreign exchange trading company in Tokyo on April 24 show the yen weakening to the 155 range against the U.S. dollar, hitting a fresh 34-year low.

EMERGENCY LANDING: An All Nippon Airways aircraft carrying 213 people landed safely at an airport in Hokkaido in northern Japan on Wednesday after a hydraulic system issue was detected. The airline said oil leaked from the Boeing 787 plane, which had departed from Tokyo's Haneda Airport and landed at New Chitose Airport, resulting in what appears to be white smoke, possibly due to the oil vaporizing as it neared the engines. There were no reports of injuries, according to authorities. The airport briefly suspended the use of its two runways but resumed operations around 10 minutes later for the one not used for the landing. The plane was later towed to an airport apron.

HONDA PLANT IN CANADA: Honda Motor Co. is planning to build a new electric vehicle factory in Canada as part of efforts to strengthen its production capacity in North America amid intensifying competition, sources familiar with the matter said Tuesday. It will be Honda's second EV plant in North America, a major market for battery-driven cars, as the Japanese automaker is currently retooling its existing factory in Ohio so it can produce all-electric vehicles from 2025.

ARMENIAN REMEMBRANCE: Schools were closed Wednesday in the Los Angeles and Glendale unified school districts to commemorate Armenian Genocide Remembrance Day, marking the 109th anniversary of the start of events widely viewed by scholars as the first genocide of the 20th century. The LAUSD Board of Education adopted a policy in 2020 to close schools on Armenian Genocide Remembrance Day. Students and teachers in the Glendale Unified School District have been given the day off on April 24 since the 2013-14 school year. A bill establishing Genocide Remembrance Day as a state holiday to be observed on April 24 and permitting public schools and community colleges to close in observance of the holiday was signed into law by Gov. Gavin Newsom in 2022.

GARDENA FIRE: A firefighter and three others were injured in a fire that tore through an apartment building in Gardena and fire officials Tuesday are investigating the cause. Firefighters sent to the 12900 block of South Vermont Avenue about 11:55 p.m. Monday extinguished the flames in the two-story building in about 45 minutes, according to the Los Angeles County Fire Department. According to a report from the scene, four apartments were involved, three with interior damage and the fourth with damage to the balcony. In addition to the four injured, 28 people were left without housing due to the fire, ABC 7 reports. The Red Cross was contacted to assist those who were displaced with temporary housing.

Delicious Little Tokyo to Focus on Cuisine & Culture

The ninth annual Delicious Little Tokyo, a one-day festival that celebrates the culinary heritage and rich cultural character of the neighborhood, will be presented on Saturday, May 4, by Go Little Tokyo.

This year's event features a wide array of activities, from food tours that explore Little Tokyo's hidden gems to immersive, hands-on workshops conducted by local chefs and artisans.

Among the highlights is a guided food tour during which participants will learn about the neighborhood's history and its most treasured small businesses while sampling dishes from local eateries. Alternatively, food enthusiasts can opt for self-guided

foodie tours, themed "Nom Nom Nihonmachi" and "J-Town Munch & Lunch."

At the Japanese Cultural & Community Center's Noguchi Plaza, free activities suitable for all ages are planned in honor of Kodomo no Hi (Children's Day), from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Kids will be able to experience Japanese flavors, games, performances, and traditions. The JACCC event will include a children's cooking competition.

Young visitors will also be welcomed at the Terasaki Budokan, where Kibo Nobori, a children's art and culture festival, will present live performances, storytelling, and a marketplace highlighting the work of AAPI creators.

Rounding out the Asian Pacific Heritage Month schedule is the 40th edition of the VC Film Fest (Los Angeles Asian Pacific Film Festival), presented May 1-10 by Visual Communications. Since 1983, the film festival has presented over 5,000 films, videos, and digital mediaworks by AAPI artists, and features seminars, panels, in-person guest appearances, and filmmaker awards. VC Film Fest continues to be the largest festival of its kind in Southern California and, according to VC leaders, "is the premier showcase for the best and brightest of Asian Pacific cinema."

Little Tokyo Community Council (LTCC) project director Kisa Ito emphasized, "We are excited to bring back Delicious Little Tokyo in collaboration with JACCC and Terasaki Budokan and the VC Film Fest. The events also recognize the 140th anniversary of Little Tokyo's founding."

An application must be post-marked by May 31 of the award year. An amount of \$5,000 is available per award. The scholarship will be awarded by June 30 of the award year.

More than 120 gathered Saturday to celebrate the Valley Japanese Community Center's with song, dance and a tribute to seven decades of achievement.

VJCC was founded in 1953 by Japanese Americans returning from the World War II camps who established a small community in what is

now Sun Valley.

VJCC president Christine Inouye welcomed the gathering at the Odyssey Restaurant in Granada Hills and said she is humbled to have held the position for the past six years.

Organizations affiliated with the community center include Valley Kendo Club, Valley Judo Institute, Akaoni Taiko, Chado Edosenke, Nadeshikokai (kimono club), Happy Yoga and the Valley

Buddhist Temple.

"We are a very small center. We are like a family," Inouye said. "We are looking forward to the future. Honestly, without everyone's help, I couldn't do it."

Yoshiko Kawada served as mistress of ceremonies and led a moment of silence for members who have passed away.

Past presidents Ron Nakamura, Ken Kageyama and Lisa Hashimoto-

Elardo were recognized with commendations.

Posthumous honors were awarded to Yoshihiro Sakaguchi, Ronald Doizaki, Mike Takimoto, Sadao Watanabe, Sally Hideko Norihiro and George Goto.

Kay Oda, president of the San Fernando Valley Japanese American Community Center, said, "I think the founders of Valley Community Center would be proud. Both community centers are doing a great job promoting Japanese culture."

Congratulatory remarks were given by Rev. George Matsubayashi, Los Angeles City Councilmember Imelda Padilla and Consul General Kenko Sone, who later joined Marisa Kosugi in singing a folk song from Hokkaido.

Ken Kageyama and his wife June both received special recognition as active members who are more than 80 years old. Kanji Sayano, Hiroyo Sakaguchi and Susumu Kono were also recognized.

Ken recalled cleaning blackboards and doing janitorial work for the center, and also entertaining children with magic. He has had to step back due to health issues.

"Thank you everyone for your support. I'm trying to hang on as long as I can," he said.

Bando Hirohichiro performed a celebratory dance. Jazz guitarist KAY accompanied Kosugi as the gathering formed a wide circle and danced "Kyushu Tanko Bushi."
